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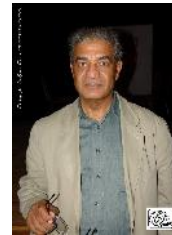

Mission Faculty of Kindergarten Cairo University

The Faculty of Kindergarten, Cairo University seeks graduating outstanding teachers to work with children in kindergarten developing their knowledge and skills that are necessary to equip children educationally, psychologically, and physically to ensure their excellence in all current and futuristic fields through programs designed to provide them with knowledge and skills basis according to international criteria and the requirements of educational, societal research projects with a full awareness of the society environmental problems and carrier ethics.

Vision of the Faculty of Kindergarten, Cairo University

The faculty vision is achieved through the academic departments of the faculty that are keen on teaching students academic and professional skills necessary for professional performance. This is achieved through studied and developed programs to equip kindergarten teacher and through getting benefits from global developments in this area by cooperating with local, regional, and international stakeholders through three axes: -

1. Education axis:

It aims at giving students the academic, educational basis and professional skills associated with the procedures, programs, and methods of teaching children as well as different teaching and learning technologies in order to promote skills, abilities, information, and directions necessary to qualify them for working in kindergarten field.

2. Psychological axis:

It aims at giving students academic, educational basis and professional skills associated with the psychological and mental characteristics to prepare programs that are convenient to those characteristics as well as early discovering of psychological and mental disturbances, different disabilities, how to deal with those of special needs and correcting children behaviors inside kindergartens and the methods of developing children abilities.

3. The cultural axis:

It aims at giving students general and specialized knowledge as well as developing cognitive and performing skills of cultural, technical, health and technological fields to help them performing their tasks in kindergarten through the Department of Sciences.
